



FP6 Long Tailed Wrap

One size: approx 60"

Materials:

5 Indulgence **OR** 5 Angora
Circular needle size 10½ or size to get gauge
Needle size 9 or 2 sizes smaller than needle used to get gauge

Gauge: In stock st, 16 sts & 20 rows = 4"

Note: Body of wrap is knit from hem to neck; tails are picked up and added later.

PATTERN REPEAT:

Rows 1-6: Stockinette
Rows 7-10: Reverse Stockinette

BODY: With larger needle, CO 168 sts (make sure your cast on edge is loose; cast on over 2 needles held together if necessary).

Row 1: k 1, p 1.

Row 2: p 1, k 1.

Change to patt rep and work the following decreases:

At 3", dec 6 sts evenly spaced across.
At 6", dec 7 sts evenly spaced across.
At 10", dec 7 sts evenly spaced across.
At 12", dec 9 sts evenly spaced across.
At 14", dec 9 sts evenly spaced across.
At 16", dec 9 sts evenly spaced across.

Work 2 more rows, then BO all sts loosely.

TAILS: With right side facing and larger needle, pick up 40 sts along one side edge (tails are narrower and will pull in, so skip sts as necessary when picking up).

P 1 row.

Next row: *k 2, k 2 tog*, rep ** across—30 sts.

Change to smaller needle and work k 1, p 1 for approx 12". BO loosely in rib. Repeat for other tail.

A little bit of luxury, our graceful wrap sits in soft folds around your shoulders...Long ribbed tails in front allow it to be tied securely. Clever bands of alternating stockinette and reverse stockinette form the corrugated folds, and gentle decreasing towards the shoulders shapes the wrap for optimum fit. This is a variation of our popular Kid Slique wrap from Book 35. Storm Angora, right and Woodlands Indulgence, above.



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
