### MATERIALS:

- 2 skeins Deep Blue Sea-Beaded Rayon
- 2 skeins Blue Violet- Confetti

### EQUIPMENT:

- Size 10-1/2 knitting needles
- Size I crochet hook
- large tapestry needle

**DIRECTIONS:** Cast on 70 stitches.

Knit in garter stitch for 65 ribs (130 rows).

Make two.

ASSEMBLE: With the I crochet hook SC along the top long side for 47 ribs. Make 3 SC for each 2

ribs(70 SC). Cut and weave in ends. Follow the side to the corner. Turn the corner and begin to crochet

along this entire side (70 SC). Do this for both pieces.

With the insides facing you place the crocheted short edge perpendicular to the crocheted long edge of

the other piece. With the Beaded rayon doubled lace the edges together with the tapestry needle by

sewing into the inner loops of the SC, alternating sides. Weave in all ends and tie a small knot before

cutting the excess. Now place the other long and short crocheted edges together and lace.

Enjoy your poncho!

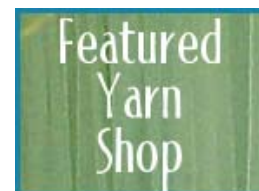
