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Pansey Sweater

Yarn:

- 2 skeins Blue Heron Softwist Wool in Pansey
- 3 skeins Blue Heron Beaded Wool in Pansey

Equipment:

- size #7 needles straight and #7 circular size F crochet hook

Gauge: 4.5 st/8rows/in chest 40" length 23" sleeve cuff to center back 28"

Lace Pattern:

Row1: K1(This # will increase at beginning and end with each repeat on the sleeves), *(K2tog) 3X, (YO, K1) 6X, (K2tog) 3X*, repeat between**, K1.

Rows 2 & 3: Knit

Row 4: K 4 st, Purl to marker, K4 st.

Main Pattern: Repeat rows 1 through 16 throughout the sweater for everything but the lace.

Row 1/2: K,K (Beaded Wool (increase)

Row 3/4: K,P(Softwist Wool)

Row 5/6: K,P (Beaded Wool)

Row 7/8: K,P (Softwist Wool)

Row 9/10: K,K (Beaded Wool) (increase)

Row 11/12: K,P (Softwist Wool)

Row13: K2, *(k2tog), (yo,k1)* repeat to last st, k1. Row 14: P (B Wool)(increase on sleeves)

Row 15/16: K,P (Softwist Wool)

Directions: This sweater is knit sideways from sleeves to center back and then cast off together at the back seam. Alternate 2 rows Beaded Wool with 2 rows Softwist Wool throughout. One pattern equals 1 repeat of these 4 rows. Always complete the pattern.

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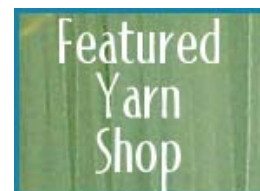
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Sleeves: (Make 2) Cast on 38 st with the Beaded Wool and make 3 repeats of the lace pattern Continue in stockinette stitch. Increase 1 st at the beginning and end of every knit row of the Beaded Wool until there are 86 st. (17" length (18" width))

Sides: (Make 2) Cast on 40 st on the next 2 rows. Place markers with 2 st in the center and 82 st on either side. Now make the increases on both outer sides of the markers on rows 1 & 9 until there are 91 st on each side. K,P with the Softwist Wool.

Left Front: Row 5(of main pattern): (BW) Knit 86 st, cast off 30 st, knit 66 st. Row 6 : P. Place the 86 back st on hold.

Row 7: (Softwist Wool) Cast off 8 st, k60. Row 8: P

Row 9: BW Cast off 6 st, k54. Row 10: P

Row 11: STW Cast off 4 st, k50. Row 12: P

Row 13: BW Cast off 2 st, make eyelet. Row 14: P

Row 15: STW Cast off 2 st, k46. Row 12: P

Row 17: BW -K. Row 18: K. Cast off 1 st. Cast off 45 st.

Left Back: Tie on BW at the neck back and begin with row 6 of the main pattern. Knit rows 7 through 16, then 1 through 4. Place this side on hold.

Right Front:

Row 7: (Softwist Wool) K. Row 8: P. Cast off 8 st

Row 9: BW- K. Row 10: P. Cast off 6 st.

Row 11: STW- K. Row 12: P. Cast off 4 st.

Row 13: BW -K. Row 14: P. Eyelet. Cast off 2 st.

Row 15: STW- K. Row 16: P. Cast off 2 st.

Row 17: BW -K. Row 18: K. Cast off 1 st. Cast off 45 st.

Right Back: Row 5(of main pattern): (BW) Knit 66 st, cast off 30 st, knit 86 st. Row 6 : P. Place the 86 back st on hold. Begin with row 6 of the main pattern and knit through row 16, then 1 through 4. Join the 2 back seams using a 3-needle bind-off.

Assembly: Sew side and underarm seams.

Bottom Lace edging: Bottom Lace: Pick up 166 stitches along the bottom edges with size 6 circular needle.(1 in corner, 5 in each space between garter rows, 4 in the center back) (166st) Knit the lace pattern 3X backward. Begin with row 3 of the lace pattern and continue with rows 2, 1 (k2 at beg and end), and 4. On the last repeat omit row 4. Knit 3 rows and cast off.

Front and Neck Band: With the circular needle and the Beaded Wool pick up 1 st in the bottom corner, 40 st up the front, 23 st along the cast off angle, 23 st to the shoulder line, 6 st to the neck turn, 12 st to the center back. Reverse along the other side. Knit in garter stitch until there are 7 ribs on the right side. Knit 1 row on the wrong side. Cast off on the right side. With the F hook and the Softwist Wool slip st into the cast off loops along the front and neck edges, turn and slip st along the bottom edge. Skip a st in the center of the inside curves and stitch loosely around the outer curves. This will encourage the line to flow. When you reach the front corner again, turn, and slip st from the back side into the same spaces. Do the same slip st edge around the cuffs.
